 Community Connections officially took over as CE provider with new helpline number on 2/1/24

- They hope to be fully staffed for Coordinated Entry by next week
- Lived Experience Team participated in two sessions of mock calls with new CE staff
- Access Services as street outreach and mobile crisis are directly handling code blue and after hours calls
- OHCD is creating CE training vidoes
- Staff still struggle with prioritization and Street
   Outreach referrals but all providers have been very patient as staff figures it out
- Significant improvements already from internal control of things like the IVR messages to change and update based on community feedback, like the hold music and the prompt recordings
- Community Feedback?
  - Joanne community feedback that many callers could not get through; this was happening within the last 2 weeks
  - Any feedback on an ongoing basis would be greatly appreciated by OHCD
  - Mark offers that increased call volume may be related to the increase in the code blue threshold and more individuals calling for assistance during code blue
- VI. RFP Status Salvation PSH: Closed, Housing Resource Centers: Closes 4:30pm (Synethia)
  - These will be evaluated and awarded in the next few months
- VII. Your Way Home Data Action Team Updates (Chris to lead)
  - Coordinated Entry Assessment Tool
    - The Data Action team continues to move forward with creating a coordinated entry assessment to replace the VI-SPDAT, which is shown to
