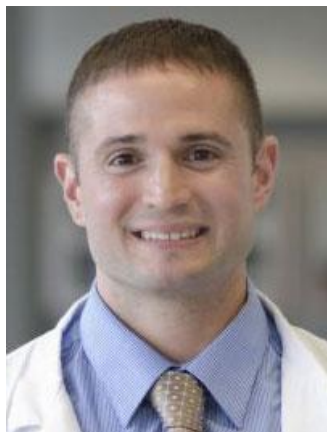

Brett Feldman, MSPAS, PA-C, is the Program Director of the Lehigh Valley Health Network Street Medicine Program. Brett largely pioneered the unique healthcare delivery system to the homeless in the Eastern Pennsylvania region. He has practiced homeless medicine for the past 9 years and founded two separate programs including the DeSales University Free Clinic as well as LVHN Street Medicine. He currently oversees 7 clinic sites located in homeless shelters and soup kitchens, the Street Team and the Homeless Medicine Inpatient Consult Service. For the past two years, Brett has spoken at the International Street Medicine Symposium in Dublin, Ireland and San Jose, California. He is a former winner of the Pennsylvania Society of Physician Assistants Humanitarian of the Year Award, Lehigh Valley Health Network Walking on Water Award and Lehigh Valley Business Healthcare Hero Award. He has been featured in multiple publications including the American Academy of Physician Assistants publication "PA Professional Magazine," and is a member of the Board of Directors for the International Street Medicine Institute.
