Standard De-Identification Policies

First name: First three letters of first name + first letter of last name

Last Name: Clarity Unique ID

For Example: Client Jane Smith will become JanS + Clarity ID when de-identified

Adult and Child profiles created the same way

Survivors of Domestic Violence Profile Creation

Survivors of Domestic Violence and their family members automatically have a deidentified profile.
